

### Recap of 2005-2006 Season By Head Coach, Jodi Hillegass

#### Westy Girls Make Return Trip to Hershey for Second Consecutive Year Third Consecutive LHAC Title and Second District VI Title in Three Years Second Consecutive PIAA State Silver Medal

The Lady Hilltoppers' 2005-2006 season was nothing short of spectacular. In true Lady Hilltopper fashion, the team carried out another historical and record-breaking season, including a return trip to the Giant Center in Hershey for the second straight year. Graduated senior letter winners Alison Battaglia, Alison Buchan, and Katie Lintner, along with Gina Cassat, helped to lead the team to a remarkable record of 31 wins and only 2 losses...Westmont's best record ever.

The team brought home their 3rd LHAC Championship in as many years. They reclaimed the District 6 Championship for the second time in 3 years. They also took the gold in the Great Chevy Shootout Tournament. This was their second consecutive 30-win season. Over the past 3 years, the team has amassed a record of 87 winds and 8 losses. The tremendous play of juniors Kelly Britcher, Karlee McQuillen, and Natalie Sheehan, along with freshman letter winner Kirsten Meenan, assisted the Hilltoppers in reaching such milestones.

There were many individual player accomplishments as well. A few include Alison Buchan signing with Division I Lehigh University. Katie Lintner was named 2nd Team All-State and signed with Division II Seton Hill University. Kelly Britcher was named 1st Team All-State and LHAC All-Star, and has already signed with Division I Duquesne University.

The whole journey began with a return trip to Hershey in mind, and together they were able to get there again. Unfortunately, their fate would grant them another silver medal, yet they will always remain gold in everyone's hearts.

## Recap of 2005-2006 Season By Head Coach, Dave Roman, Jr. Westmont Boys Score 101 Points in Single Game, Two Players Break School Records Team Advances to First Round of PIAA Playoffs

Coming off of a 15-13 season, in which the Hilltoppers rallied late in the season to reach the District 6-AA Championship Game, not many knew what to expect from the 2005-2006 Hilltoppers. This is a program that has averaged 20 wins over the past 8 seasons, to hover around .500 was uncharted waters. The Hilltoppers got off to a fast start by cruising to wins over Conemaugh Valley and United to capture their 11th straight title in the Hilltopper Classic tip-off tournament. Mark Rossi took home MVP honors. Westmont went on the road to face Penn Cambria in the LHAC season opener. The Hilltoppers enjoyed a 30-point win (51-21) over the Panthers. The Hilltoppers took a 5-2 record into the Windber Rotary Tournament where they would face District 10-AA power Lakeview High School. Westy defeated the Sailors 68-50 to advance to the championship game versus the Windber Ramblers. The Hilltoppers defeated Windber 62-49 to capture their second tournament championship of the season.

#### Westy Scores 101 Points

Westmont reached an unusual milestone in high school basketball as they topped the 100-point mark in a 101-67 win at home versus Somerset.

The last week of February brought on what seems to be an annual event, Westmont versus Marion Center in the second round of the District 6-AA Playoffs. These teams have met in the playoffs for the past three seasons. The familiar opponents would produce a familiar result as the Hilltoppers defeated the Stingers 60-49 at Central Cambria High School. Junior Joe Balog led Westmont with 15 points. Max Khuri chipped in 10.


The District 6-AA Semi-Finals matched LHAC rivals Westmont and Bishop McCort at Central Cambria High School. In a typical knock down, drag em' out game between these two schools, the Crushers prevailed 54-51 with a long offensive rebound and desperation 3-pointer at the buzzer. Junior Joe Balog led Westmont with 17 points. The loss would have the Hilltoppers fighting for their PIAA lives as they would face Bishop Guilfoyle in the third place game for the right to advance to the State Playoffs. Westmont would face Bishop Guilfoyle at Central Cambria High School with a State Playoff birth on the line. The two teams battled to a 17-all tie at the end of the first quarter. Joe Balog scored 8 of those points including two 3-pointers in the opening frame. The Marauders would take a 39-38 lead into the half. Westmont responded to Coach Roman's halftime adjustments and outscored Bishop Guilfoyle 19-12 in the third quarter. The Hilltopper's, who struggled from the foul line all season, responded by making 10-14 free throws in the final quarter to hold off Bishop Guilfoyle 76-70 and advance to the PIAA Playoffs. Brad Kanuch scored a career high 18 points while Michael Thompson added 16 points to pace the Hilltoppers.

The first round of the PIAA Playoffs would put Westmont against the #8-ranked team in the state of Pennsylvania, Quaker Valley. The Quakers were led by Division 1 point guard Amir Johnson. Coach Roman and his staff believed that they had a game plan that would allow the Hilltoppers to defeat the highly ranked Quakers. Westmont held true to the game plan and led 13-11 after the first quarter and took a 26-25 advantage into halftime. In the second half, Johnson showed why he will play Division 1 basketball as he poured in 14 points in the second half. The Quakers talent took over and outscored Westmont 36-25 in the second half to defeat the Hilltoppers 61-51. Westmont held Quaker Valley to their lowest point total of the season. The Quakers would eventually advance to the PIAA Western Championship where they would lose by 1 point to Beaver Falls. Joe Balog was the lone Hilltopper in double figures with 19 points.

#### Two Players Break School Records

Two school records were broken during the 2005-2006 season. Joe Balog broke Nick Mezyk's (2002) 3-point percentage by connecting on 44 of 91 (48.5%) attempts. Also, the 2006 Westmont-Hilltoppers shattered the team's 3-point % by making 133 of 327 (41%) shots on the season.

With seven lettermen returning, Coach Roman is excited to begin the 2006-2007 campaign. "This is one of the hardest working groups we have had in my nine seasons at Westmont," said Coach Roman. "The combination of work-ethic, experience, and team chemistry that this group possesses should allow for another successful season."

Person I'd most like to meet: Jesus Christ Athletic Hero: My Dad, Dave Roman, Sr.


